#### Describing words (Adjectives)

• The words that are used to describe a noun or 'naming' words are called as adjectives.

e.g. red rose, blue sky, white milk

Types of Adjectives: There are two main types of adjectives.

- 1. Qualitative: It gives more information about the quality of an object i.e. colour, size, shape, weight, speed etc.
- 2. Quantitative: it gives more information about the noun in number or amount form.
